## Thursday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, 8pm: *The Wanted* 18



(Palestine, 2014, Paul Cowan, Amer Shomali, 75") Mixing humorous clay-figure animation with live action, the film depicts the power of nonviolent resistance in occupied Palestine. Villagers import 18 cows for their milk, but for Israel they represent a security threat. Ingenuity is the villagers' response. The film is a poignant account of nation-building from the bottom up: not by the rulers but by the ruled. "Unexpectedly humorous" - The Hollywood Reporter. "Mind-opening" - Variety. "An entertaining absurdist satire" - LA Times.

Venue: **Circolo ARCI Arcobaleno**, 1 Via Pullino (Garbatella)

### How to get there:

**Metro:** B line to the Garbatella stop; take the Via Pullino exit; go right to Piazza Albini; via Pullino continues on the other side; at n°1, at the end of the block, go down the steps into the ARCI/Arcobaleno clubroom.

**Bus:** 673 from San Giovanni or Colosseum, 715 from P.za Venezia, 23 from Trastevere.

**Film begins at 8pm**, with a **special event** from 7 to 8pm: a pre-film discussion on the "Boycott HP" initiative in support of Palestine, as well as the "refusnik" (conscientious objector) movement in Israel. Three young Israeli women are about to go on trial and face years in prison for refusing Army induction, in order to protest against their nation's military occupation of Palestine. December 1 is the international *Day of Prisoners of Conscience*.

The film is free (but small donations are welcome). Arcobaleno membership is €7 per year (valid for various discounts in Rome).

**Change in schedule** No film on Dec 15<sup>th</sup> so our next showing will be **January 19<sup>th</sup>**, with the probable Oscar nominee for this year's best documentary: "**13th**" by Ava DuVernay.
