WHAT KINDS OF FILMS ARE WE LOOKING FOR? ABOVE ALL, DOCUMENTARIES THAT GET PEOPLE THINKING ABOUT WHAT'S REALLY HAPPENING IN THE WORLD – FOR EXAMPLE, REGARDING THE CLIMATE, THE ECONOMY, THE WARS WE SOMEHOW ARE ALWAYS INVOLVED IN.

OUR GROUP WAS, IN FACT, FOUNDED BY CONCERNED U.S. CITIZENS LIVING IN ROME, WITH THE PURPOSE OF UNDERSTAND CURRENT EVENTS IN GREATER DEPTH (AND MORE HONESTLY) THAN WHAT MAINSTREAM MASS MEDIA REPORT AND THEN ACTING ON THAT KNOWLEDGE.

MICHAEL MOORE'S 1989 HIT “ROGER AND ME” OPENED UP A NEW SEASON OF THOUGHT-PROVOKING DOCUMENTARIES, AIMED AT GIVING PEOPLE ALTERNATIVE INFORMATION ABOUT CURRENT EVENTS. SINCE THEN, A PLETHORA OF FILMMAKERS HAVE FOLLOWED HIS EXAMPLE. OUR TASK (AND YOURS, IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO JOIN IN) IS TO SCOUT OUT THOSE FILMS, DISCUSS THEIR MERITS DURING PRE-SEASON PROGRAMMING MEETINGS, AND THEN CHOOSE THE BEST ONES FOR SCREENING DURING THE YEAR. MANY ARE GREAT LOW-BUDGET PRODUCTIONS MADE TO CIRCULATE ON THE INTERNET . THEY CAN BE EASILY DOWNLOADED. (SEEING THEM ON A BIG SCREEN, WITH A DISCUSSION AFTERWARD, WILL ENHANCE THEIR VALUE!)
